

Austrian Youth Strategy

The Austrian Youth Strategy is an ongoing process to strengthen and further develop youth policy in Austria. The aim is to bundle and systematise measures for young people and optimise their effectiveness. The youth strategy is also intended to identify new areas of co-operation and further need for action, and to underpin these with concrete measures.

The four fields of actions serve as a framework: Learning and Employment, Participation and initiative, Quality of Life and a spirit of cooperation, Media and Information

Together with all federal ministries, Austrian youth objectives are developed and underpinned with measures. The development of new youth objectives and measures is possible at any time. Youth objectives and measures are subjected to a reality check in terms of active participation: they are developed and reflected upon with young people and organisations that have youth expertise. Research findings are also taken into account.

The youth objectives and measures are also assigned to the European Youth Goals and thus contribute to their implementation.

The overall coordination and strategic development of the Austrian Youth Strategy is carried out by the Youth Competence Centre at the Federal Chancellery. The inter-ministerial coordination process and ongoing participation in the overall process are ensured through the establishment of central coordination in each federal ministry. An inter-ministerial coordination round ensures cross-sectoral co-operation.

A regular implementation report provides information on the transparent and participatory further development of the Austrian Youth Strategy.
